



Enrich your child's or student's experience of listening to one of our fairy tale or fable stories! Use these cards to start engaging conversations.




What was your favorite part of the story?






How did the story make you feel? Why?






If the story continued, what do you want to happen next?






If you could be in the story, which character would you be? Why?






How did your feelings change about the characters in this story?






What are the problems some of the characters faced? How did they solve them?






Do you think adults can learn anything from this story? Share your ideas!






Have you ever been in a situation liked the one we heard about? What did you do?






What do you think we can learn from the story?
